Enhance your child's ability to learn

Hearing difficulties can significantly affect a child's ability to learn. Children with hearing loss may experience speech and language delays, educational difficulties, behavioural problems and often require increased educational support.

Our audiologists provide a comprehensive diagnostic and rehabilitative audiological service for babies through to teenagers. Our professional and friendly staff offer a complete range of paediatric assessments in our purpose-built paediatric clinics, conveniently located at UQ's St Lucia campus.



The UQ Audiology Clinic provides screening and diagnostic hearing services and a range of interventions and management strategies designed to meet your child's needs. Research demonstrates early detection and intervention can influence a child's speech sound development, expressive and receptive language development and even their literacy skills.

Let the UQ Audiology Clinic enhance your child's ability to learn through our following specialist paediatric services:

- **Central Auditory Processing Tests:** for children aged seven years (predominantly 8 years) and above
- **Hearing Assessments:** comprehensive assessments for infants through to school-aged children
- **FM Fittings:** specialised equipment to assist children in hearing better within noisy classroom settings
- **Swimming earplugs and musician plugs:** to protect your child's ears
- **School Hearing Screening Service for schools and colleges:** our program is conducted within the school facility during school hours and is generally offered to children from Prep to early primary. We are also happy to screen children in older grades on request. Children aged under three years require specialist testing within the UQ Audiology Clinic.
