The UQ Telerehabilitation Clinic offers the opportunity to have an allied health consultation and treatment in a location convenient for the client. Child, youth and adult services are available in any environment – home, school or workplace.

What is Telerehabilitation?

- Telerehabilitation uses technology to deliver real-time rehabilitation services to clients in their homes or local community using the Internet.

We provide services to help with:

Activity and participation

- Aspects of learning, including writing, self-management and organisation
- Play and social interaction skills
- General coordination and participation in physical activities
- Independence in daily tasks (such as dressing, using cutlery)

Movement

- Muscular or joint pain
- Pre or post-surgery
- Postural or work related problems
- Changes in balance and falls prevention

Communication

- Difficulty being understood by parents, teachers or friends
- Difficulty speaking clearly
- Stuttering or stumbling over words
- Struggling with reading or spelling
- Using the wrong words in a sentence
- Ongoing speech therapy services after injury or medical event
